CAMPAIGN ENTERING FINAL PHASE

Brothers, with five months left in the campaign, success is in sight! We are now confident that with a couple of pending pledges **we will hit our \$1.2 million goal**. I am so very thankful to everyone who has been able to participate thus far.

At the Foundation board meeting held June 21, we approved a \$1.4 million construction budget (yes, more than the \$1.2 million raised so far). We also awarded the project to Fort Wayne-based Kinder and Sons, a firm that does similar work on college campuses and is run by **Doug '91** and **Mike Kinder '95**. We have also approved a major kitchen update and improvements to the first floor common spaces to give the house an updated look. These are in addition to a long list that includes new heating and air conditioning (for the first time), a fire suppressant sprinkling system, electrical upgrades, a new roof, and suites on the third floor.

We started the project with the new roof earlier in the summer. The balance of the work

is to be done the summer of 2014, so that the undergraduates will not be displaced.

We were told early on in this process that some brothers would only get involved when they felt the campaign was going to be a success and others only when construction actually started. I sure hope that is the case as **we have met both of these goals, and we certainly still need additional funds** to cover the extra work and at least a portion of the campaign costs.

We wanted to make sure we provided an update on activities with the Chapter. We are seeing significant progress on many fronts by the undergraduates. Grades are up 30 places from a year ago. This has been aided in no small part by an alumni-funded initiative that provided tutors to the Chapter every week and individual tutors as needed. We finished third in athletics and third in Grand Prix. Campus involvement is up, and the Pike Fireman's Challenge is being well received by the community and supported by the Greek system. All this has made recruitment more successful, leading to a waiting list for rooms next fall! What a turnaround. Both the Home Association and the Alumni Advisory Board are stronger than ever and our communication with the undergraduates is very good.
